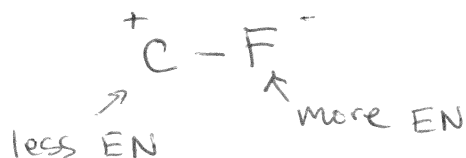
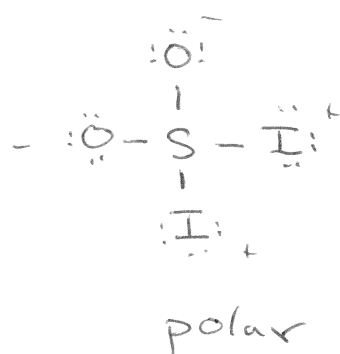
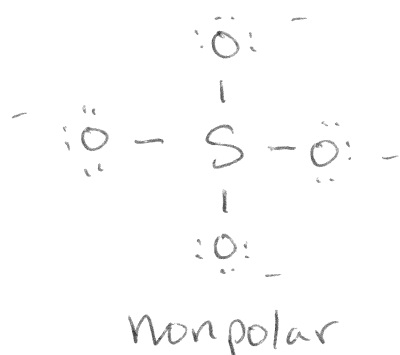
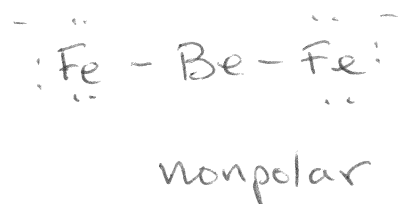
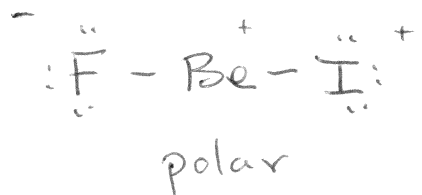


Polar Molecules For Pre-comp

- In order for a molecule to be polar it has to have opposite charges (+, -) on opposite ends of the molecule.
- Polar molecules have polar bonds. A polar bond contains 2 atoms that differ in electronegativity. (EN)



For the Pre-comp: Polar molecules must have at least one external atom that is different than the others.
